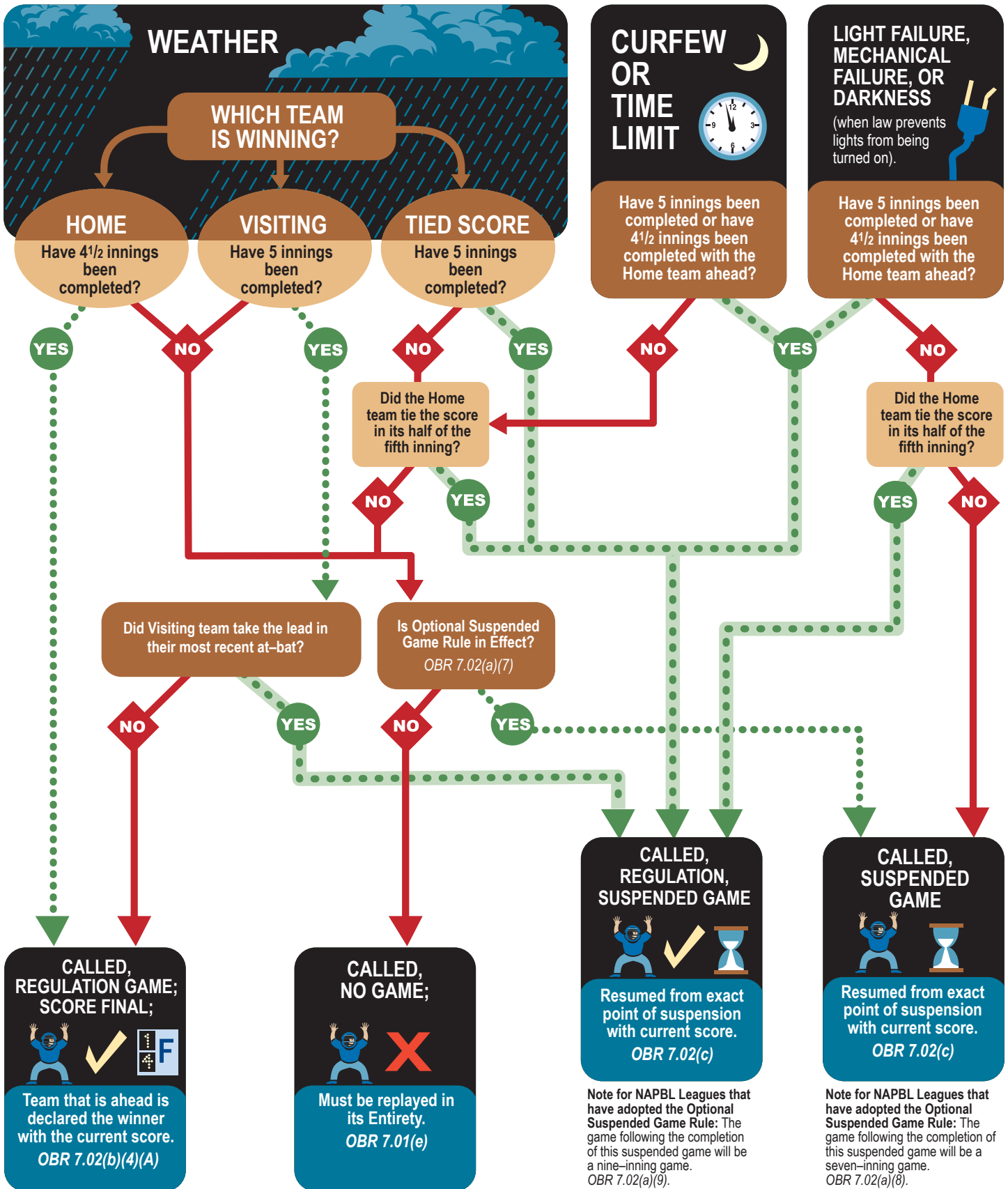

STATISTICS

All statistics compiled up to the moment the game was called will be counted.

REPORTING ATTENDANCE

No change to regular attendance-reporting procedures.

**CALLED,
NO GAME;**



Must be replayed in its Entirety.
OBR 7.01(e)

STATISTICS

Statistics compiled during the game are **NOT** counted.

REPORTING ATTENDANCE

No attendance is reported and one lost opening is reported.

**CALLED,
REGULATION,
SUSPENDED GAME**



Resumed from exact point of suspension with current score.

STATISTICS


IF THE GAME IS COMPLETED: Statistics compiled during the game are counted (and are considered to have happened on the date of the originally scheduled game.)

IF THE GAME IS COMPLETED: The attendance from the game's originally scheduled date is used (regardless of whether the game was scheduled in a different location from where the game was completed.)
